Goal: to identify ways to leverage the CIE for ACES Aware.

Use Cases Findings:

- Using the CIE for Shared Intake (screening questions)
- Look up history for trauma-informed care (support system)
- Aggregate Data (Community Reporting)
- Informed Care, Identifying concerns and resiliency
- Strength-based, flagging referrals
- Identify concerns and resources (Referrals)
- Prioritization of Care, use screening to prioritize access to resources

COVID-19: EVICTION PREVENTION COLLABORATIVE

Laura Ann Fernea from City Height Development Corporation spoke on the Eviction Prevention Collaborative

Mission: Coordinates And Expands Resources And Data, In Order To Prevent Avoidable Evictions And Homelessness, Protect Against The Spread Of COVID-19 And Disease, And Safeguard Children From Eviction's Long-term Damages

Starting in April, there will be a communications campaign in English and Spanish which will use radio and online marketing strategies to reach thousands of San Diego renters and send them to the website to access:

- TENANT RESOURCES – links to the public (based on zip code) and private rent relief funding, and
- TENANT INFORMATION & EDUCATION - online presentations and workshops to learn about tenant rights, updates in housing laws (such as eviction moratoriums and SB 91).
