# Traveler's Aid San Diego

## Homeless Outreach Program

Provides information and referral services, vouchers for free San Diego birth certificates, homeless certifications, senior transportation services (Pronto, taxi, volunteer driver...), and reduced fare vouchers for DMV Identification Cards to homeless clients residing in San Diego County. Does not assist with shelter placements, permanent housing assistance, or hotel/motel vouchers.



## Orientation and Mobility Training

Travelers Aid has hired an Orientation and Mobility (O&M) Trainer. The new O&M trainer will assist low-income individuals with vision impairments or other permanent disabilities orientate from home to public transit. The participants must complete an application that they can receive by calling the office.



# Traveler's Aid San Diego

## SenioRide

COVID-19 Update: Rides are limited to medical rides and grocery shopping due to COVID-19, call for more information. Helps pay transportation for medical and social needs for low-income seniors ages 60 and older. Forms of transportation assistance include: volunteer drivers, door-to-door services, taxis, and senior bus passes. Transportation services are offered within San Diego County. Services may not be offered in some areas. Do not assist with gas vouchers. Also offers homeless certifications, birth certificate vouchers for San Diego County, and ID vouchers.



## Senior Solutions - ACS

Provides transportation funding to cancer-related medical appointments through MTS Access, NCTD Lift, Uber, Lyft, and taxis.

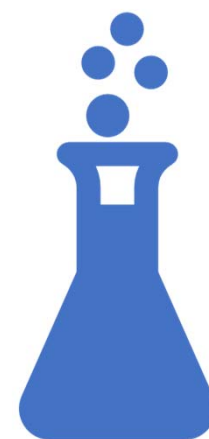

# Z-Codes

## What are



SDOH-related Z codes ranging from Z55-Z65 are the ICD-10-CM encounter reason codes used to document SDOH data (e.g., housing, food insecurity, transportation, etc.).

SDOH are the conditions in the environments where people are born, live, learn, work, play, worship and age.

- ICD-10-CM codes are used to properly note diseases on health records, to track epidemiological trends and to assist in medical reimbursement decisions.
- Z-codes are used to determine eligibility for CalAIM services and are required for authorization processing to health plans for services such as Enhanced Care Management and Community Supports

## Categories of z-codes, 25 total priority z-codes

Z code	Description
Z55	Problems related to education and literacy
Z56	Problems related to employment and unemployment
Z57	Occupational exposure to risk factors
Z59	Problems related to housing and economic circumstances
Z60	Problems related to social environment
Z62	Problems related to upbringing
Z63	Other problems related to primary support group, including family circumstances
Z64	Problems related to certain psychosocial circumstances
Z65	Problems related to other psychosocial circumstances

## Z-Codes & CIE

- 211/CIE has completed data mapping for 25 DHCS defined priority z-codes
- Z-code data of CIE consented clients/members will be shared back to contracted health plans to assist with identifying potentially eligible clients for ECM
- Z-codes will be displayed on CIE client records to help providers confirm potentially eligible clients and to assist with authorization process

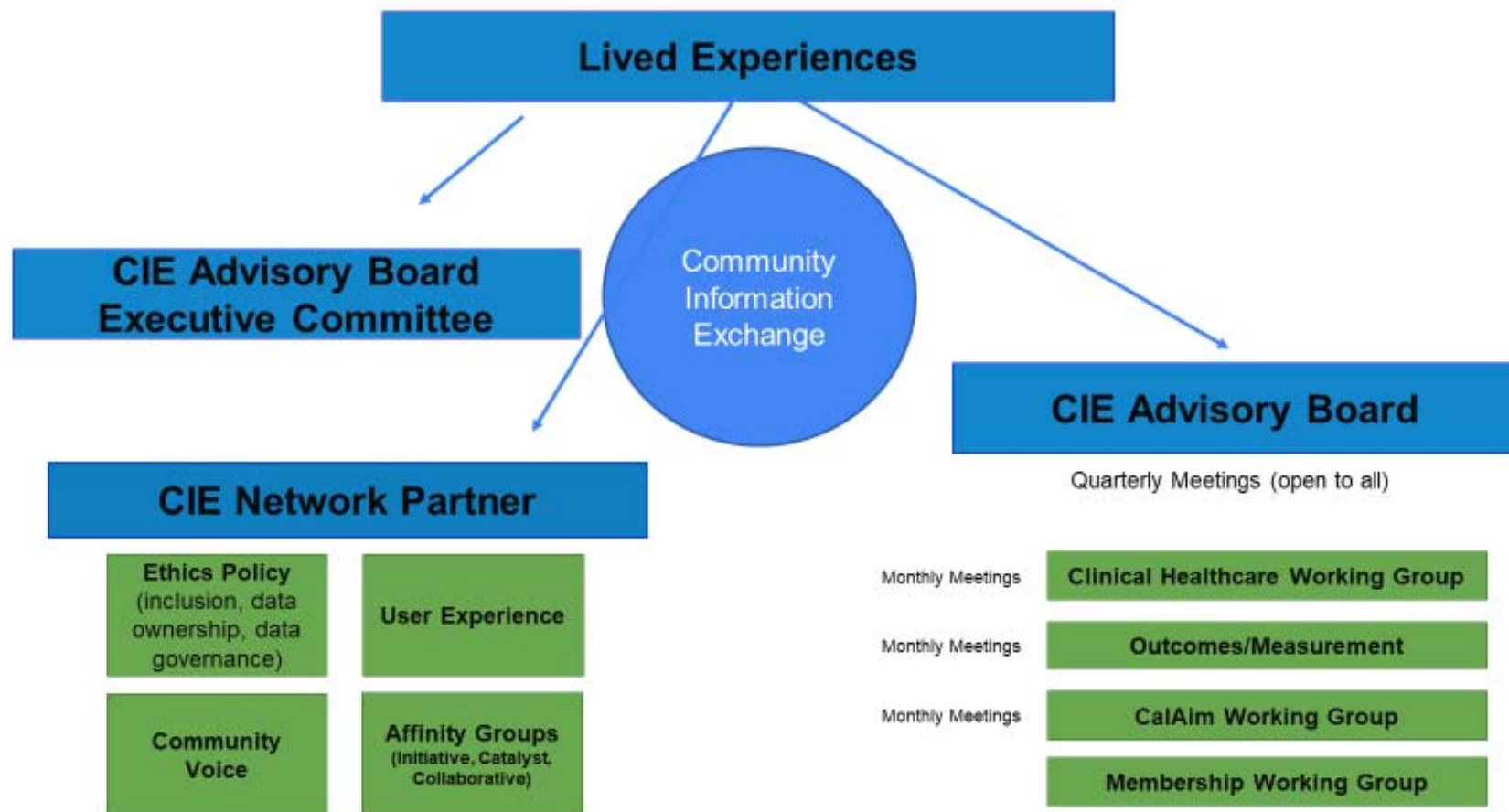

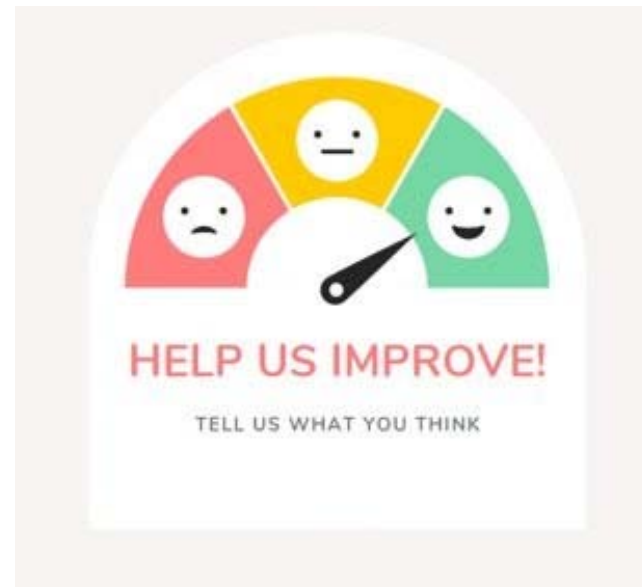
